Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Subscription Rate Program

People's Energy Cooperative headquartere	ed in Oronoco, Minnes	sota (hereinafter	referred to as the
"Cooperative") and	(herein	after referred to	as the "Member").

The named parties understand and agree to the following:

- 1. The Member understands that this is an optional program for EV charging at a monthly subscription rate as outlined in "Rate Schedule EV997/EV999" and approved by the Board of Directors.
 - a. Charging is available 24/7.
 - b. A monthly subscription rate applies, and energy rates vary based on the time of day the EV is being charged.
 - ➤ Charging during overnight hours, weekends, and holidays are included in the monthly subscription rate up to a limited kWh amount. Charging outside of these times or exceeding the allowable kWh's will be billed to the member as outlined in the rate schedule.
 - c. The Member understands they may choose to move to another available and appropriate rate at any time only after being enrolled in this program for a minimum period of 12 months.
- 2. A separately metered, hard-wired, 240-volt, level-two charger is required and must be connected to a second meter which is in addition to your primary meter for your main service.
 - a. The Member may purchase the charger through the Cooperative, which has an integrated meter and does not require the member to install a separate meter socket. Or the member may bring their own charger, which will require the installation of a separate meter socket.
 - b. Rebates are available for EV chargers. Refer to the electric vehicle charger rebate form for eligibility requirements.
 - c. The member is responsible for ensuring the home electrical system will handle the additional EV charging capacity and any upgrades required are at the cost of the member. It is recommended that a licensed electrician assess the home electrical system prior to the purchase of an EV charger.
 - d. The installation of the EV charger is the responsibility of the member. It is recommended that a licensed electrician perform the installation.
- 3. Member must submit pictures of their clearly labeled electrical panel and any equipment connected to the charger's panel prior to receiving the EV charging subscription rate.

- 4. Services with an interconnected distributed generation system, who participate in the Cooperative's community solar program or who have their main service on a time-of-use rate, do not qualify to have a sub-metered service and are required to have this service parallel metered.
- 5. The Cooperative shall not be liable for any personal inconvenience, damage, or economic loss due to power interruption, such as an outage.
- 6. The Cooperative reserves the right to modify the terms and conditions of all rate schedules from time to time.
- 7. This Agreement shall be in effect as of the date indicated. When service under this subscription rate is terminated, the member will be moved to an appropriate rate and the Member shall not be eligible to apply for this rate for a period of 12 months.
