### **Power restoration continues**

**ORONOCO, MN, April 13, 2019 (4:00 p.m.)** — Restoration of broken poles and downed power lines continues in the southern portion of People's Energy Cooperative's (PEC) service territory.

Since dawn, crews have been working in the townships of Ashland, Canisteo, Farmington, Frankfort, Grand Meadow, Hayfield, High Forest, Jordan, Pleasant Grove, Pleasant Valley, Quincy, Racine, Rock Dell, Vernon, and Viola.

Efforts will continue this evening until crews must be pulled for mandatory rest and will resume early tomorrow morning. As of 4:30 pm there are approximately 300 members without power.

If a PEC member is without power and they have not called it in, they should call the Cooperative at (800) 214-2694 to ensure we are aware of it. If power was restored and went back out, it's important to report the new outage.
