Possible weather-related power outages

ORONOCO, MN, April 26, 2019 (4:00 p.m.) — A winter storm warning has been forecasted to begin tomorrow (April 27) at 7:00 a.m. with weather conditions that could damage power lines. People's Energy Cooperative reminds members to be prepared for the possibility of extended outages due to damage on an already weakened system from Winter Storm Wesley.

It is important to keep an emergency kit stocked with the following supplies: water, flashlights, extra batteries, non-perishable food, a manual can opener, a battery-powered or hand-crank radio, first-aid supplies, and back-up prescriptions.
