SCAM ALERT

ORONOCO, MN, June 30, 2020 — A member of People's Energy Cooperative (PEC) was the target of a scam this afternoon after receiving a phone call from someone who indicated they were on their way to the service address to shut off power. The caller then asked if they could “transfer them to customer service to make payment.” Thankfully, the member hung up and called PEC to report the incident.

PEC would like to remind people that if they receive a call from someone claiming to represent a utility company, and the caller is asking for personal information, hang up and call the customer service number on your bill. It is very important to remember that PEC staff will never request bank or payment information from members over the phone. Member service representatives will only ask for information to identify who a member is. Members of People's Energy Cooperative who receive such a phone call are encouraged to hang up and call PEC directly at (507) 367-7000.
