Hoefs, Wooner and Orth Reelected to People's Energy Cooperative Board of Directors

Oronoco, MN, March 29, 2017 – Results of People's Energy Cooperative's (PEC) director elections were announced during the Cooperative's 80th Annual Meeting held at the Rochester International Events Center on Wednesday, March 22, 2017.

Six candidates vied for three seats with three-year terms on PEC's Board of Directors. The results are as follows:

District 3 incumbent Robert Hoefs of Mazeppa defeated challenger Ronald Jensen. Hoefs won with 1,272 votes and Jsensen received 858 votes.

District 5 incumbent Jerome Wooner of Eyota ran unopposed and received 2,010 votes.

District 7 incumbent Jeffery Orth defeated challengers Joe Jacobson and Theresa Hornberg. Orth won with 1,224 votes, Jacobson received 466 votes and Hornberg received 467 votes.

The theme of the meeting was "Celebrating 80 Years Strong" and featured speakers included PEC President/CEO Elaine J. Garry, PEC Board Chair Jerome Wooner, and PEC Secretary & Treasurer Kenneth Wohlers. More than 450 PEC members and guests were in attendance.

At its Board meeting held on March 28, the Cooperative Board re-appointed Jerome Wooner as the Board Chair, Robert Hoefs as Vice Chair, Kenneth Wohlers as the Secretary/Treasurer and Eugene Miller as a Dairyland Power Cooperative Board Member.
