## During the summer months, unpredictable severe storms can develop. When trees fall on lines, lightning strikes poles, or tornados develop – the power can go out. When you lose power – what should you do?

- **Notify us of the outage, even if you think your neighbor did.**

When there are widespread outages during a storm, outage reports are critical for us to understand exactly where outages are happening. If you don't want to wait on the phone to talk to someone, you can report the outage through SmartHub, our account management system, or through outage texting. - **Stay away from downed power lines.**

Storms can cause hidden hazards. Stay far away from downed power lines, whether they are covered by tree branches or lying in the middle of the street. There is no safe way to determine whether or not a power line is energized, so it is best not to go near any electrical equipment that is damaged.

- **Keep an eye on social media for updates.**

We will post regular status updates on Facebook and Twitter when there are widespread and major outages throughout our system.
